
## SKIES OF BLUE & CLOUDS OF WHITE - BARCELONA'S WONDERFUL WORLD

This month cruise news has been buzzing with the arrival of Wonder of the Seas to the port of Cadiz for her technical stop prior to her first season around the Caribbean islands. She made her way across the Atlantic to Fort Lauderdale for her inaugural voyage on the 4th of March.

Measuring close to five times larger than the infamous Titanic, the newest addition to Royal Caribbean's Oasis Class fleet has a capacity of 6,800 passengers and 2,400 crew members.

The Wonder of the Seas is expected on the 8th of May for her first turnaround operation at Barcelona Cruise Port where she plans to start her summer season exploring the Western Mediterranean.
